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### **Marion County Indiana Recorder's Office to Issue Request for Proposals for Land Record Management System and Other Services**

Indianapolis, IN – The Marion County Recorder's Office will issue a request for proposals (RFP) in the coming weeks for software and services related to its core business functions.

The RFP will be divided into four scopes of work: land record management system, remote search services, bulk data services, and microfilm creation. Qualified vendors will have the opportunity to bid on specific scopes or all four.

The existing contract for these services expires in 2020. Local ordinance requires an RFP be issued for these services.

#### **Recorder's Office Statistics**

- Over 10 million records are fully indexed and available to search online dating back to 1964. An additional 2.5 million records from 1821-1964 are searchable by Book and Page and/or instrument number.
- The office recorded an average of 531 documents daily and over 132,000 documents in total in 2018. 70% of those were received electronically.
- The office received over \$6 million in recording fees in 2019.

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
